



What is Yard Waste?

Yard waste consists of grass clippings, leaves, prunings, branches, house plants, fruits and vegetables and other refuse that is generated by yard and garden maintenance.

SEASONAL YARD WASTE COLLECTION BEGINS JANUARY 1, 2015

Beginning January 1, 2015, yard waste will no longer be collected on Wednesdays. During the months of January, February, March, and December residents may place 5 bags, bundles, or containers of yard waste out for collection to be included in their 10-container limit of trash.

Christmas trees will be picked up on Wednesdays throughout the month of January. Make sure all decorations and lights are removed. Do not place trees in plastic bags.

Wednesday yard waste collection will resume April 1 and continue through November 30. During this time, residents are to place their yard waste in either 30-gallon biodegradable paper bags or in a regular twenty (20) to thirty-five (35) gallon trash container with handles and a tight-fitting lid. Bags/containers shall weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds when full. Cardboard boxes, plastic bags, or biodegradable plastic bags, may not be used as these will not be accepted at the composting facility. Tree branches (no thicker than six (6) inches in diameter) are to be bundled into four (4) foot lengths and placed next to the yard waste at the curb. Do not rake leaves into the street.
